

2009 Tournament Rules for NEAAU State Tournaments, Super Regionals, NE Championships

Girls and Boys

The 2009 NEAAU Super Regional will play under the 2008-2009 National Federation of State High School Association except where amended.

Dress code:	All Coaches must wear slacks, polo shirts, team shirt or warm up suits. <u>NO Hats.</u>
Bench Coaches:	Teams are allowed 3 coaches per team and they must be on their rosters and all must be AAU members. <u>All coaches must have coach's credentials and must wear them at all games.</u>
<u>Home Team:</u>	<u>Higher seated team in the pool or in bracket play top team in the bracket.</u>
Game time:	Starting time will be enforced to the minute. There is no grace period. Teams will be given a minimum of 5 minute warm-up time.
Time:	Ages 13u thru 17u will play (2) 16 minutes halves of regulation. Overtimes shall consist of 3 minute periods. Ages 10u- 12u will play (2) 14 minute halves of regulation. Overtimes shall consist of 3 minute periods.
Halftime:	3 minutes
Timeouts:	Teams will have 2 timeouts per half to utilize. There will be no carryover of timeouts from halves. <u>1-timeout will be permitted per overtime period.</u>
Fouls:	Teams will shoot 1 and 1 on the 7 th team foul and double bonus on the 10 th team foul. Girls can enter on the release
Personal fouls:	Individuals will have 5 fouls. On the 5 th personal foul he shall be disqualified.
Pressing:	<u>There will be no pressing full court if a team is ahead by 25 points any time in the game</u>
Ejections:	Any player or coach ejected from a contest shall sit out the next contest and may be suspended from participating for the remainder of the tournament.
Tournament Play:	All teams will advance to the Championship Bracket. Head to head play will be the first determination of pool winner. A maximum of 15 point differential will be utilized in determining how to break ties in the pool for boys and 12 for girls.
Protests:	A coach must file a protest within 2 hours of completion of protested contest. This MUST be in writing and given to the Tournament Director or Boys Basketball Chair. It MUST be accompanied with \$100 cash refundable deposit.
